The Sue Baldwin Fund

The Sue Baldwin Fund was established in 2007 to help Door and Kewaunee County women and men in the fight against breast cancer. The mission of the Sue Baldwin Fund is to support breast cancer awareness, screening, treatment and care for those who have an economic need.



Financial Assistance Program Purpose

The Sue Baldwin Fund provides direct financial support for breast cancer patients and survivors so their focus can be on healing and recovery.

Summary

The Sue Baldwin Fund is available to men and women who reside in Door and Kewaunee Counties. Applicants who are eligible for financial assistance are those who are seeking breast cancer screening or diagnostic services, have completed or are currently undergoing active treatment*for breast cancer, or are seeking mental health support.

*The board defines active treatment as radiation, chemotherapy, and/or surgical interventions

Policy

The policy for the Sue Baldwin Fund exists to guide the Board of Directors in processing requests from breast cancer patients who have applied for financial assistance.

1. The Sue Baldwin Fund Board of Directors meets monthly. Applications will be reviewed at that time.
2. The Sue Baldwin Fund will assist as many applicants as possible as funds permit. The Board of Directors reserves the right to distribute assistance amounts based on funds available.
3. The Sue Baldwin Fund will provide all assistance directly to the vendor or medical facility. There will be no reimbursement directly to applicants; however, we do have a gift card program for groceries or gas.
4. Once an initial application has been submitted and reviewed, an applicant in active treatment may contact the board for additional assistance. Once active treatment ends, an applicant seeking assistance needs to submit a new application.
5. Requests for assistance with mental health support for children and partners of the applicant are also encouraged.

Application Process

1. The applicant requesting assistance will complete the application and mail it to The Sue Baldwin Fund, P.O. Box 243, Egg Harbor, WI 54209
2. Once the application is received, a member of the Sue Baldwin Fund Board of Directors will contact the applicant. The Board will review the application at their monthly meeting and consider the request for financial assistance.
